- *Inventory*
- *Destruction*
- *Inventory Transfer*
- *Disposal*



Note: This effort does NOT include handling/disposal and/or Transportation of nuclear or radioactive waste



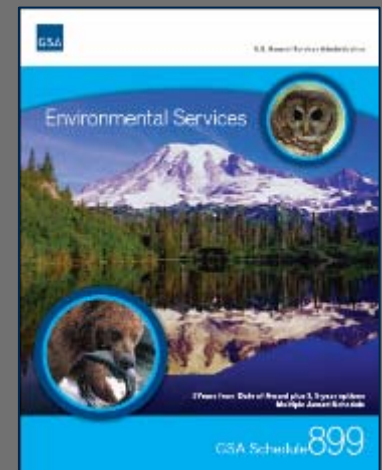
